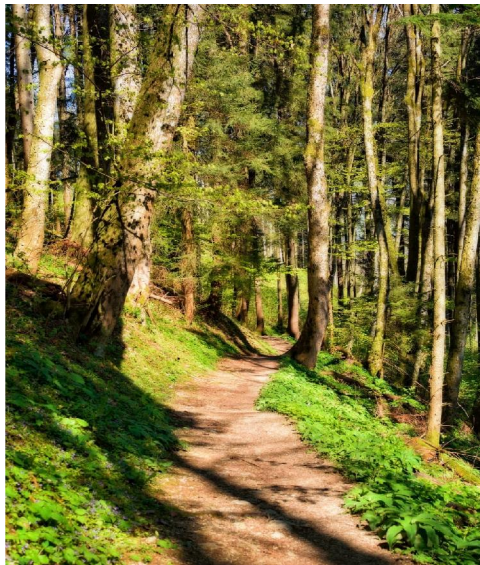
## **Priest's Message**
